**Scripture – Proverbs 31:10-31**

**Main Message – A mother's heart is never far from those whom she loves and especially when God is a part of her life.**

Proverbs 31 has some scripture that can create some conflict in the heart of a woman. On one hand it sets up a nearly impossible target and goal to live by, like scripture does for us all.
