~~Sermon – Praying through the Scriptures~~

Scripture – Psalm 24

Main Message – If we allow scripture to guide our prayer life, we will be drawing closer to him through His very own word.

Prayer is powerful. It is made more powerful by considering the Holy Scriptures themselves. Left to our own devices, it is too easy to get trapped into the, “I need..., I want, Lord heal..., Fix this... etc..” Now there is nothing wrong with praying for these things, but we must consider that we will be more in line with HIS perfect will if we come to him with the recognition that he is GOD ALMIGHTY, and not the cosmic genie we would like to invoke on our behalf.

We will read Psalm 24 today.

Regard how you would pray each of these verses and how it might put our own Spirit and heart into the proper frame of mind. After each very I will have you respond with, “He is God Almighty”

Vs:1 – With this Psalm we recognize that it is all HIS, everything, and even us that dwell here and there is no escaping this truth. This might already begin to modify our prayer thoughts when we recognize His supreme authority. He is God Almighty.

Vs 2 – He brought dry land out of the depths of the oceans. Who here can say the same. He is God Almighty.

Vs 3 – This question is for every living soul. Who indeed will ascend to where the Lord lives? Who dares to stand in the Holy place? The most serious of questions has an answer, but it is by his hand alone the answer comes, Because, “He is God Almighty.”

Vs 4 – The answer, is given. Our look into our own heart tells us the truth. We have all failed this test. All have us in some way have deceived others and prided ourselves on things that are not wholesome. “He is God Almighty”

Vs 5 – The reward is hard to fathom. Do you feel blessed, and righteous? If you do, then you are His child. Praise him for, He is God Almighty.

Vs 6 – This is the time to seek him. Not tomorrow, not when it’s convenient for you. This is the first pause to reflect upon all that we have read and all that we have heard in our hearts. He is God Almighty.

Vs 7. This is the door to your heart, your mind, your very soul. Open up and let him in. Throw away your earthly desires and embrace his Glory. He is God Almighty.

Vs 8. He is King. He overcomes all things because he is beyond our understanding and above all our ways. “HE is God Almighty.”

Vs 9. We are a sinful generation. We must remind ourselves to always have the door to our heart open. Don’t just let Him into your life, but invite HIM into your life. “HE is God Almighty

Vs 10. The Lord, yes he is the KING of Glory. Lord I must see you as who you are and recognize that you are in charge of all things, creator of all things and I am simply a person, whom you love. Why do I ever resist your ways. Who am I. Do with me as you will O’ Lord. I’ve learned this lesson yet again, ~~You are~~ GOD ALMIGHTY.
