Sermon – A Helmet (Gospel Armor Week – Part 4)

Scripture – Ephesians 6, Several Psalms, Emphasis on Psalm 27

Main Message – When you know your eternal soul is truly taken care of, you will never fear for yourself again.

I don't get the question often, "Do you think I'm saved?" I'm glad because I can't possible judge that – truly. Let's say you ask yourself that sometimes however. That is a place of doubt, which is never a good place to be. A core reason for this is that people are still stuck thinking they aren't good enough. Here's the irony. You aren't. You never will be. Your doubt regarding your salvation is why you're stuck. The Holy Spirit isn't able to do much because you are still in neutral. You are never worthy on your own merit, but knowing what Christ has done on our behalf is the **ONLY REASON** why we are saved. **Having doubt is opening the door to fear.**

So put on the helmet of salvation because when you truly KNOW you are saved, then the doubt is gone - your faith becomes effective. Are you still struggling with some kind of sin? Its not that your aren't saved, its that you still don't believe that Christ has done everything for you.

We put on this helm of salvation. That is protecting our brain, which is kinda important isn't it? It is given to us by God. We didn't make that helm, any more than we made truth, or righteousness or any of the pieces of armor that we must be wearing. Here are some scriptures to bring home this point of salvation and its source.

[Psa 3:8 KJV] 8 Salvation [belongeth] unto the LORD: thy blessing [is] upon thy people. Selah.

[Psa 27:9 KJV] 9 Hide not thy face [far] from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

[Psa 37:39 KJV] 39 But the salvation of the righteous [is] of the LORD: [he is] their strength in the time of trouble.

[Psa 38:22 KJV] 22 Make haste to help me, O Lord my salvation.

God has many names due to his infinite qualities as the Supreme Creator. Jehova Jireh, Jehova Rapha, Jehova Shalom, Jehova Teshoowa.

His very name means the God who delivers/salvation.

Don't let doubt come in. Please. Let us say you no longer doubt, that you know you are saved. Keep that helmet on, especially when you are being attacked by either your internal voice or the enemy who wants you to fear. Don't let it happen. You can face anything knowing your eternal soul is protected by HIM who actually MADE it all.
